Read This First

If you're using Apple[®] Macintosh OS X version 10.2, you need to download and install a new version of the TWAIN driver for use in OS X 10.2 Native mode instead of the driver that comes on your EPSON Stylus CX CD-ROM.

Follow the instructions on the *Start Here* sheet and in the *Macintosh Software Installation* booklet that came with your EPSON Stylus CX to set up the Stylus CX and install the basic Stylus CX printer software. **However, follow the steps** below instead when you come to the instructions titled "Installing Additional Software for Mac OS X."

Installing Additional Software for OS X

1. After your Macintosh restarts, double-click the EPSON CD-ROM icon to open it, if necessary.

Do not install EPSON TWAIN 5 from the CD-ROM.

Do not install EPSON Scan to File from the CD-ROM.

- Double-click the Film Factory Installer icon to install Film Factory
 for OS X. Follow the on-screen instructions.
- 3. Double-click the **PhotoImpression Installer** icon to install ArcSoft PhotoImpression. Follow the on-screen instructions.
- 4. Double-click the EPSON Information Center or User's Guide Installer icon to install your on-screen documentation.
- 5. Open the OS X Applications folder, then open the Utilities folder and double-click Print Center. Make sure your Stylus CX model name appears in the printer list.
- 6. Close Print Center and remove the CD-ROM, then download and install the new TWAIN driver as described on the back of this sheet.

Downloading and Installing TWAIN 5.75

- 1. To access EPSON's support site to download the latest software for your EPSON Stylus CX, open your browser and go to http://support.epson.com.
- 2. Click Drivers & Downloads, then select All-In-One under Printers.
- 3. Select your Stylus CX model. A list of available software downloads appears.
- 4. Scroll down to Macintosh Operating Systems and locate the download titled TWAIN Driver 5.75A.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instructions to download and install the TWAIN driver.
- 6. Now start up your Macintosh in OS 9.x. Follow the instructions in your *Macintosh Software Installation* booklet to install the OS 9.x drivers and additional software.

Note: The TWAIN 5.75 driver is not designed to work with earlier versions of OS X; you can't scan using TWAIN 5.75 on OS X 10.1.x or earlier.
