Overview

The time is shown at the top of each KDS display and can be configured.

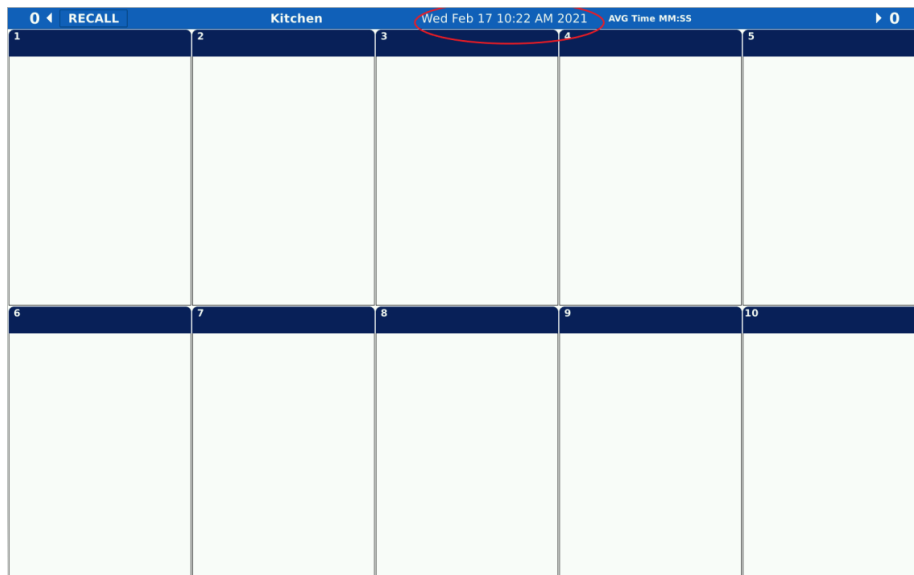


Figure 0.1 – Kitchen Display Showing the date and time

How to Configure

This procedure sets the current KDS time to that of the PC that is running the Configuration Utility.

Step 1: Configuring Time Settings

1. Select **Setup**.
2. Select **Site Wide Settings**.
3. In **Time Setting Actions**, click “**Set Current KDS Time**”.
4. **Apply KDS Settings**.

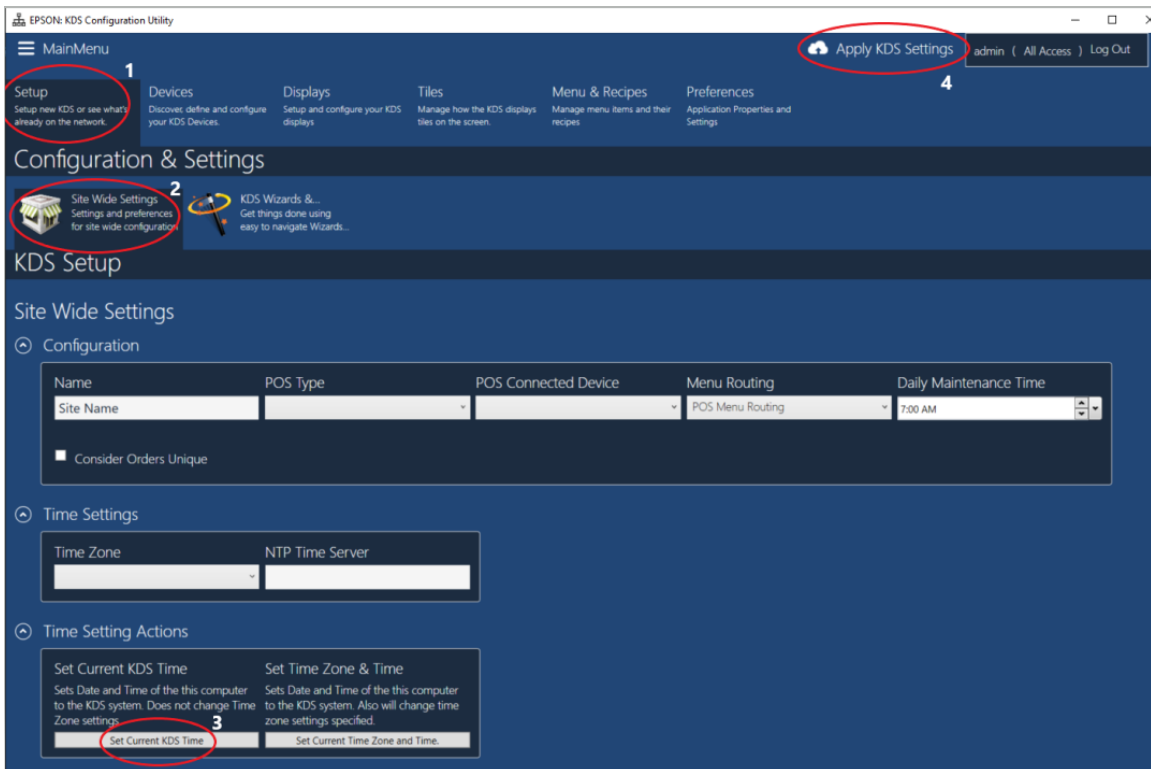


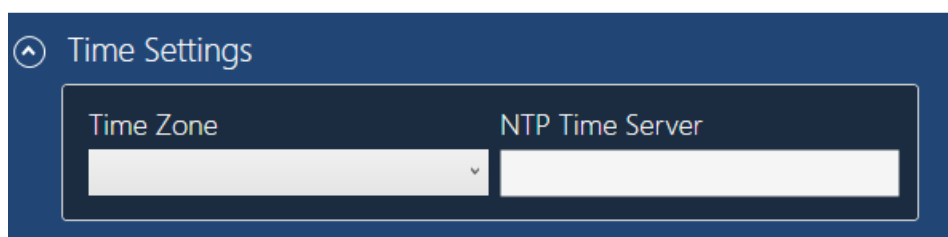
Figure 1.1 – Configuring Time Settings

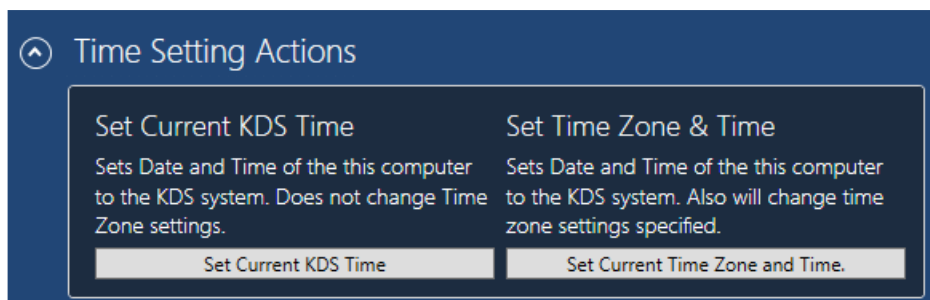
Time Settings

Time Zone: The system support time zone settings. Choose your time zone and click “Set Time & Time Zone setting” in the Main Menu. This will update the master device (If selected) to the new time zone settings and the current local time.

NTP Time Server: Specifies NTP Time Server. This setting must be applied by clicking “Set Time & Time Zone Settings” in the Main Menu.



Time Setting Actions



Set Current KDS Time: Sets the date and time for this computer to the KDS system. Does not change the time zone settings.

Set Time Zone & Time: Sets the date and time for this computer to the KDS system. It will also change the specified time zone settings.
