

# **Adding a Station**


### **About this Guide**

## **Overview**

Additional KDS devices can be easily added to your KDS configuration. TrueOrder allows up to 9 displays in a single system setup.

# **How to Configure**


This guide assumes that you already have a Single Station KDS system setup as described in the TrueOrder KDS Single-Station Quick Start Guide. Multi-station KDS systems require all devices to be connected on a local network. This guide assumes that your new device has been connected to the network with your existing KDS device.

## 1. Add New Layout

You will need to create a new Ticket and Grid layout before you can add a new station.


#### Add New Ticket

- 1. Select Layout.
- 2. Click Tickets.
- 3. Click Add New Ticket.






- 4. Name the Ticket.
- 5. Click Save.




## Add New Layout

- 1. Click Grids.
- 2. Click Add New Layout.





- 3. Name your new Layout.
- 4. Select **Ticket Design** from list (this will be the new ticket you created "**Ticket 2**").
- 5. Click Save.







## 2. Apply New Layout to Station and Device.

## Add New Device

- 1. Click Stations.
- 2. Select Device Config.
- 3. Click Add New Device.




4. Search for your connected Device.






### 5. Select Device.



6. Name the Device.




7. Click Save.




### Add a New Station

- 1. Click Stations.
- 2. Click Add New Station.



- 3. Name new **Station** (e.g., Station 2)
- 4. Choose Station Type Kitchen, Expeditor, Customer Facing
- 5. Select Layout 2.





- 6. Select Device 2.
- 7. Click Save.
- 8. Click Publish.
